**2. STAFF REPORTS**

**2.1. Discussion and possible action to conduct interviews and appoint City Council Member for Ward 4 to serve the remainder of the term for Council Member Susan Seidl who resigned effective August 16, 2019.**

City Manager Hooper explained that three candidates will be interviewed, Mr. William Burrows, Mr. Timothy Creiglow and Mr. Albert Torres. She stated each applicant will be given 30 minutes to answer a series of questions. In the interest of fairness, candidates were asked to wait in the Community Room until there were called in for their interview. City Manager Hooper explained the interview questions will be asked from the dais by Human Resource Specialist Shannon McKnight. The order was determined by a name draw. Once the interview was conducted, candidates were invited to remain in the Council Chambers for the duration of the meeting. She stated once all the interviews have taken place the council will deliberate. The successful candidate will be sworn in at the August 21<sup>st</sup> City Council Meeting.

After a random drawing, Mr. Timothy Creiglow was interviewed first. Mr. William (Bill) Burrows was interviewed second and Mr. Albert Torres was interviewed third.

City Council took a break between the second and third candidates from 5:52 – 5:57.

City Manager Hooper explained the deliration needs to take place on the dais. She stated the Mayor is allowed for vote during this process.

Councilmember Torres will serve the remainder of the term which ends in 2020.


**ADJOURNMENT**
